



PROF. JAMES GOETZ PHOTO ESSAY COMPETITION



The Department of Biological Sciences is proud to sponsor a Photo Essay Competition in honor of James C. Goetz. Professor Goetz was a professor in the Department of Bio-logical Sciences from the Fall of 1971 until his death in May of 2010. He was a naturalist and photographer who spent many years photographing and videotaping plants and animals in habitats ranging from the United States to Africa, the Amazon, and the Galapagos. His photographs and specimen collections can be seen in the halls of the Arts and Sciences building, as well as in the library.

A **\$2000** award will go to the student who submits the best original photo essay and **\$1000** to the runner up. These must align with an annual theme described on the application form and must be submitted by **May 1st**. Eligible students must have a 2.0 GPA or higher, and must be enrolled in or passed at least one college biology course. Winners will be announced by **June 1st**.

Applicants must submit a narrated slide presentation that includes 10 original photographs. Narration must describe the content, location and date of each photograph, as well as how each photograph relates to the theme. Narration must be in the applicants own voice. A valid CUNY ID must be visible in the corner of each photograph (not pasted in).
