Learn the fundamental knitting skills that can transform novices into practiced knitters able to tackle a variety of future projects with confidence. Practice knit and purl stitches to begin and finish a project. With expert guidance, explore the tricks of the trade to fix mistakes along the way.

NHB 65 Sewing for Beginners Tue 6:30-8:30pm April 28-June 16

Learn basic home sewing machine operating skills including threading your machine and bobbins, basic stitches and finishes as well as learning pattern layouts, fabric cutting, sewing construction and finishing techniques. Students will construct two projects: a basic envelope back pillow cover, and a tote bag. Each week will focus on a different stage of the project and by the end of all sessions students will have a completed product while building a solid foundation of sewing skills.
