From: Course stresses solution of elementary algebraic equations, word problems and applications. Introductory Algebra for those who fail the Algebra portion and pass the Arithmetic portion of the COMPASS Math Skills Test.

To: Course stresses solution of elementary algebraic equations, word problems and applications. Introductory Algebra for those who fail the Algebra portion and pass the Arithmetic portion of the COMPASS Math Skills Test.

*Demonstration of proficiency in subject matter via exit exam is required for successful course completion.*

3. MAT 0R300, *Algebra*

From: Topics in elementary algebra for students who pass the Arithmetic portion and score between 30 and 45 on the Algebra portion of the COMPASS Math Skills Test.

To: Topics in Elementary Algebra for students who (1) pass the Arithmetic portion of the COMPASS Math Skills Test or the KCC Pre-Algebra Skills Test and who (2) have not achieved the algebra proficiency level required for MAT 00900. *Demonstration of proficiency in subject matter via Department final exam is required for successful course completion.*
