EMS 81XX - INDEPENDENT STUDY (1-3 crs. 1-3 hrs.)

Independent study of emergency medical services is developed individually between student and faculty member and must be approved by the department. Examples of independent study can be: the student serves as an EMS Resource Specialist and provides peer mentoring and tutoring to paramedic students, the student conducts research regarding EMS or EMS education methods, the student investigates an EMS-related issue and its impact in the field or profession.

RATIONALE

After careful review of the first cohort of paramedic-level students entering fall 2014, the creation of new 81 course will allow for currently certified paramedics to enroll in the AAS in EMS-P Program. Since currently certified NYS paramedics will receive 36 transfer credits toward the degree, the student still needs to complete the 20 credits of general education. This new 81 course will provide the additional credits through independent study in order to complete the required 24 credits at Kingsborough Community College.
