Curriculum Change Proposal

English 6400: The Literature of Adventure and Exploration (3 Credits 3 Hours)

Catalog Description: A study of the writings associated with major aspects of American adventure and exploration, such as the "discovery" of America, the Frontier, the Wild West, the National Parks, the development of tourism, and the space program. Writers to be studied will include Columbus, Lewis and Clark, Thoreau, Twain, Cather, and Silko.

Explanation for Deletion of Course: This course has not been offered for many years. The content of this course is satisfactorily covered in English 48: American Environmental Literature.
