The Department of History, Philosophy and Political Science is proposing a change in **Course Description** and **Prerequisite** for **POL 9300 Global Politics**

Course Description

FROM:

Introduction to contemporary global politics and a cap-stone course for the A.A. in Liberal Arts' Global Environment Studies Concentration. Survey of topics including war, terrorism, security, poverty, the environment, human rights, international organizations, gender issues, inequality, the global economy and international law. Additional time is required for an internship in an organization working on global and environmental issues.

TO:

This course introduces students to central issues facing the global community including war, terrorism, security, poverty, the environment, human rights, international organizations, gender issues, inequality, the global economy and international law.

Prerequisite:

Prerequisite(s): Open only to Liberal Arts Majors who have accumulated 45 or more credits

TO:

Prerequisite: NONE

Rationale for Changes:

1. The content of the course remains the same. We are just taking out references to deleted curricular requirements. The Global and Environmental Concentration has been deleted and there are currently no capstone courses in liberal arts. There is no longer any internship requirement.
2. Since the course is not part of a concentration sequence, we are also getting rid of the prerequisite.
