RE:	Change in Course Description for MUS 3100 – Introduction to Music

The Department of Communications & Performing Arts is proposing a change in Course Description for MUS 3100 – Introduction to Music:

## FROM:

Development of perceptive awareness of music through guided listening. Materials and forms of music and their use in musical literature.

### TO:

Through this survey course in Western Music History, students will explore the evolution and history of music, ranging from the Medieval Period to the twenty-first century, through the study and analysis of musical works written by European and American composers. Students will listen to and analyze various art music genres including instrumental solo music, chamber and orchestral music, as well as vocal genres in order to examine the evolution of form, compositional techniques, and instruments that have occurred throughout the past one thousand years in Western Music. Further, students will engage in the critical listening of a variety of musical works from these time periods in order to assess elements such as texture, timbre and melody structure.

### **Rationale for Change:**

The previous course description is incomprehensible. The change in course description will now properly reflect course content rather than consist of vague sentence fragments.
