The Department of Mathematics & Computer Science is proposing a change in description for HTML Authoring and Javascript (CIS 2200):

## FROM:

A second course in design and development of web pages emphasizing HTML coding, interactivity, animation and ecommerce applications of the World Wide Web. Students will develop their own web pages using web page software.

## TO:

A second course in design and development of web pages emphasizing HTML coding, interactivity, animation and ecommerce applications of the World Wide Web. Students will develop their own web pages using web page software. This course covers the content of Microsoft Exam 98-383: Introduction to Programming Using HTML and CSS.

**Rationale for Change:** Course is enhanced by the inclusion of appropriate preparation for the relevant credentialing exam. This is in keeping with the University's initiative to provide our students with the recognized micro-credential certification to enhance job readiness.
