The Department of Mathematics & Computer Science is proposing a change in description for Computers and Society (CP 300):

FROM:

Introduction to computers and how they are used, as well as the impact they have had on society.

TO:

Introduction to computers and how they are used, as well as the impact they have had on society. The course explores the impact computers and information technology have had on society and demonstrates lessons via a variety of software tools and information technology resources. The course material includes coverage of subject matter that will prepare the student for the Google Workspace certification exam.
