Spring 2025 College Council Updates

I hope everyone had a great holiday and a fantastic start to the new year. I am writing to invite you to the upcoming College Council Meetings. The first College Council meeting will occur on February 11th, 2025, in U-219. As we start to plan the forthcoming agendas, we have time sensitive topics that will be introduced under the Two-Meeting Rule (a rule that states an agenda item has to be discussed at one meeting and then can be voted on at the next meeting). The first major item for the February 11th College Council meeting is the Two-Meeting Rule discussion for ratifying our updated Constitution. With our Middle States visit scheduled late March 2025, it can benefit us to approve our constitution prior to the visit. We have made a lot of changes to the Constitution since the last ratification. The updated Constitution reflects our ongoing efforts to enhance shared governance and ensure that our practices align with our College's evolving needs. The revised Constitution will be available to the College for review before our Council meeting on February 11th. By having the meeting on February 11th, the Legislative Committee will have time to make any necessary changes brought up during the discussion, and allows for the ratification of the updated Constitution before the Middle States team arrives. The agenda for the 2/11 Council meeting will be finalized at the Steering Committee meeting on 1/28 at 10 a.m. in V-227 Conference Room.

The next time sensitive agenda item that will be brought to the Council later in the semester and under the Two-Meeting Rule, is the approval of the new Strategic Plan. Many College members are working hard to develop this plan, which will help guide our College's direction and priorities in the coming years. Although these are two major topics for the upcoming semester, we still have many other agenda items to discuss this semester. I am confident that we can accomplish these important goals by working together and continuing to build a stronger and more vibrant College Council.
