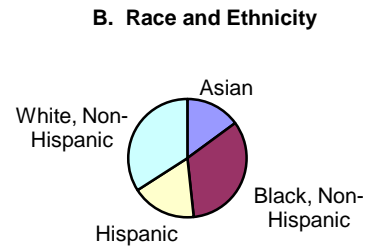

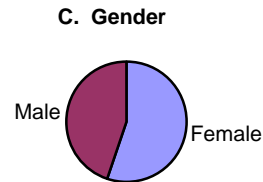

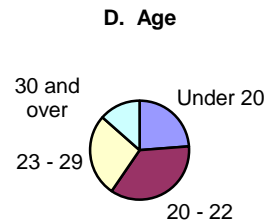

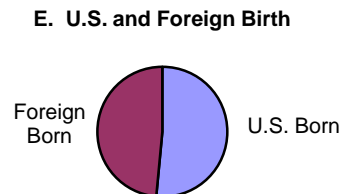

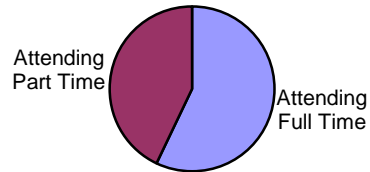

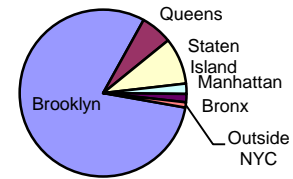

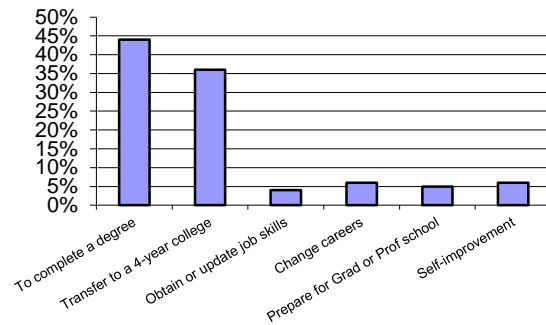

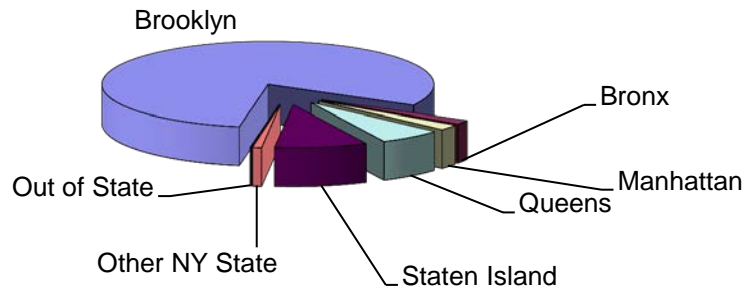


M. New Degree Student Distribution

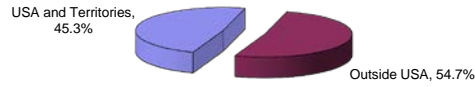

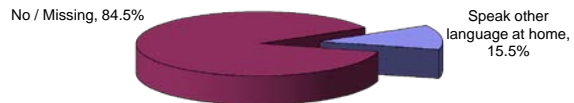

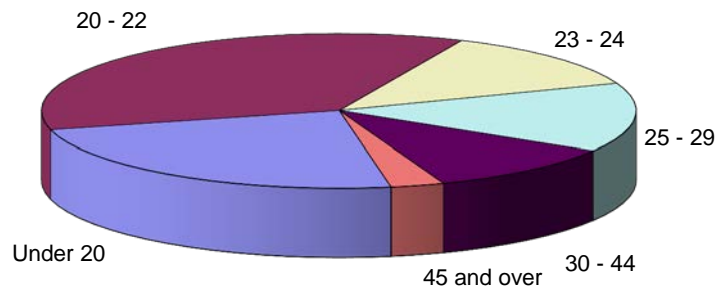

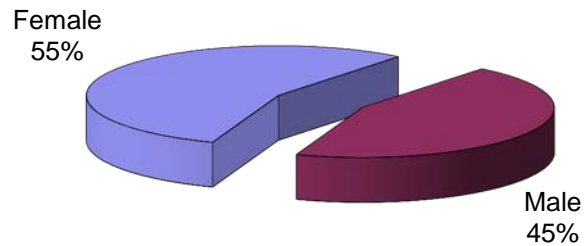

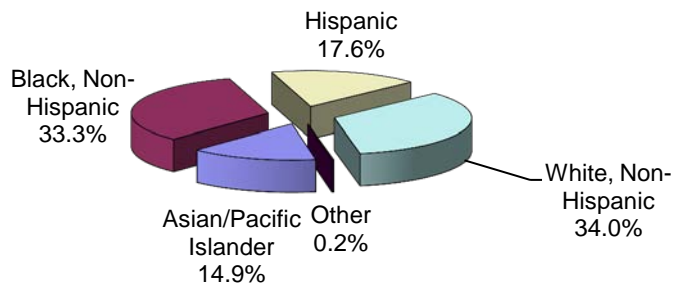

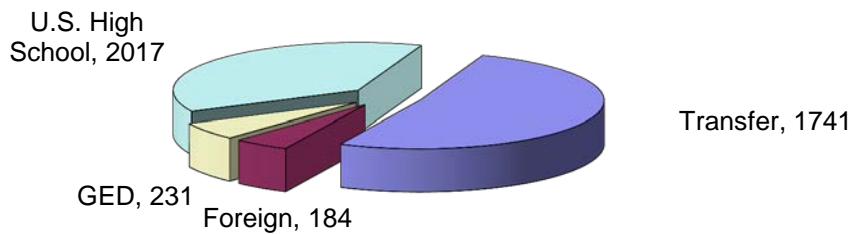

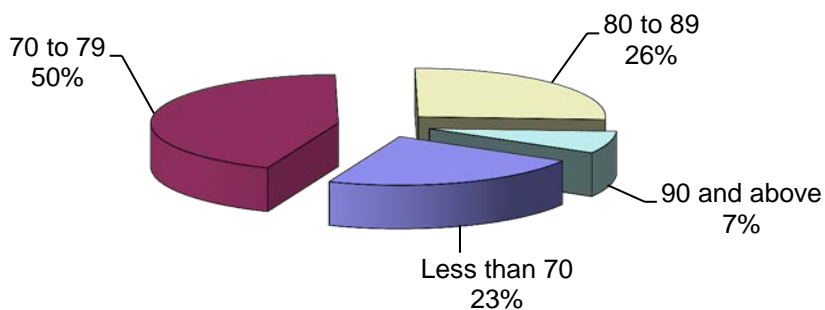

 Freshmen Passing**



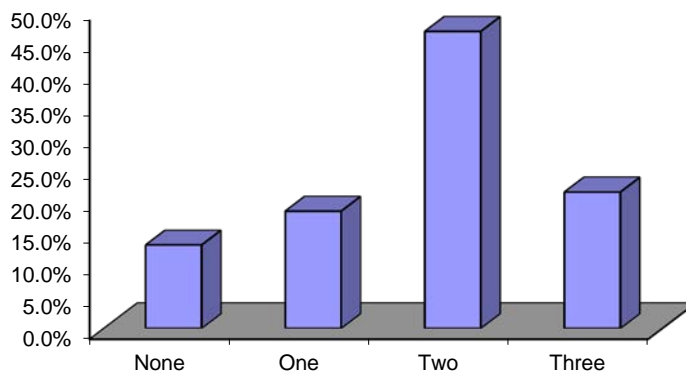

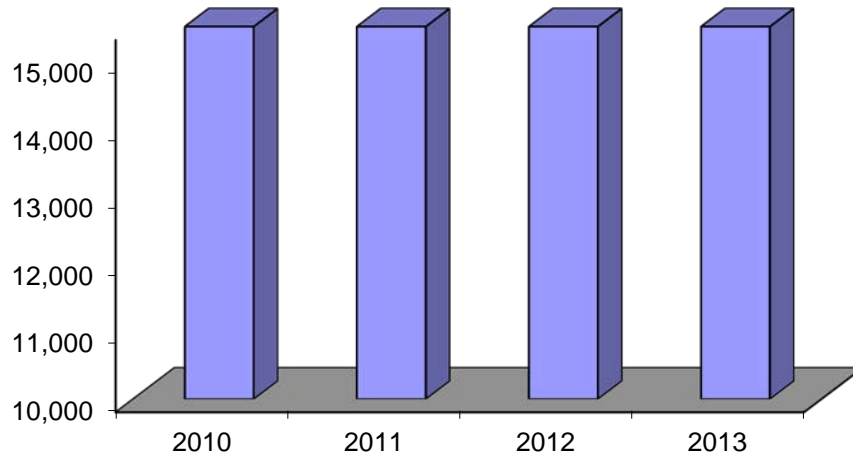

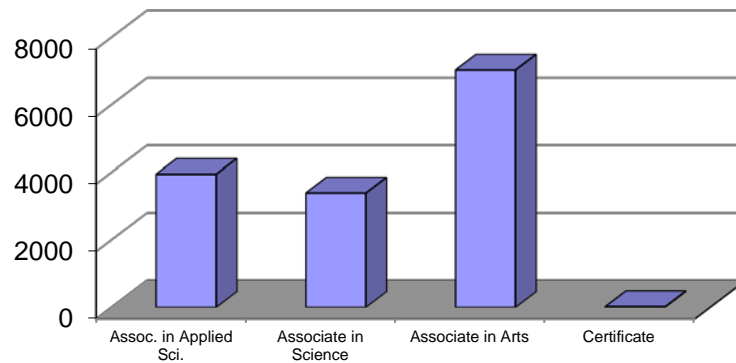

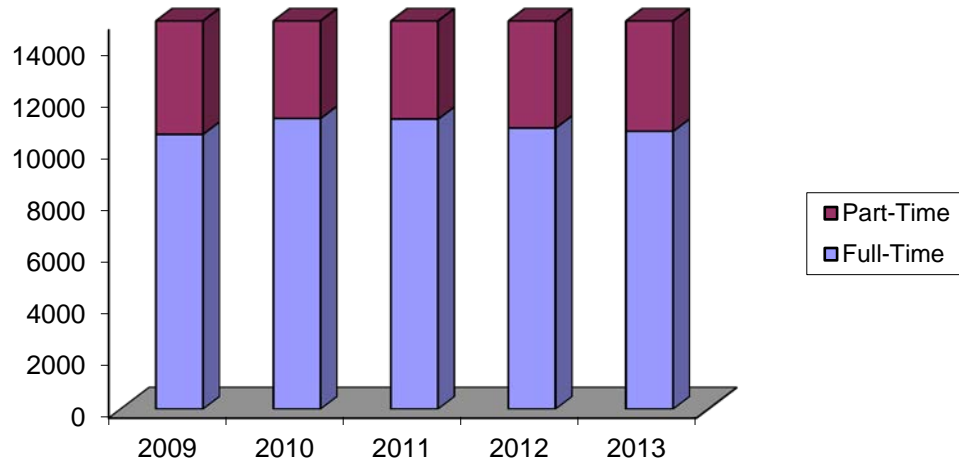

Credit Students By Full-time and Part Time Status Fall 2009 to Fall 2013



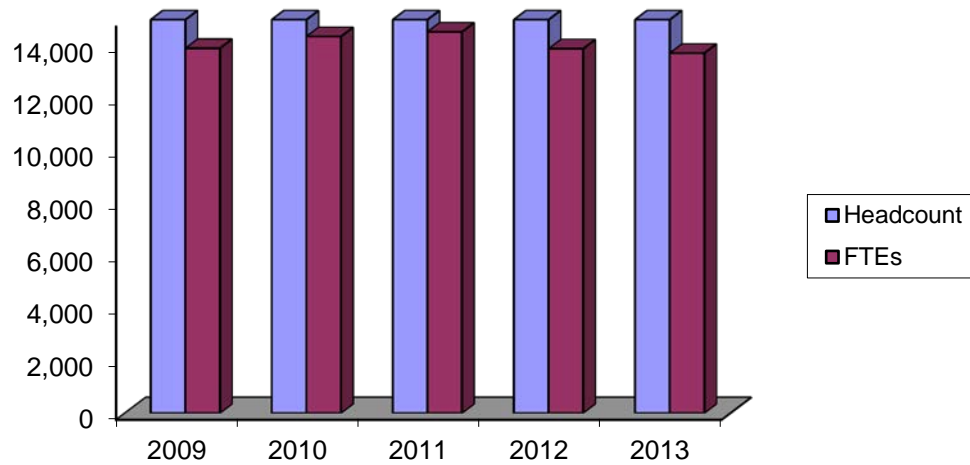

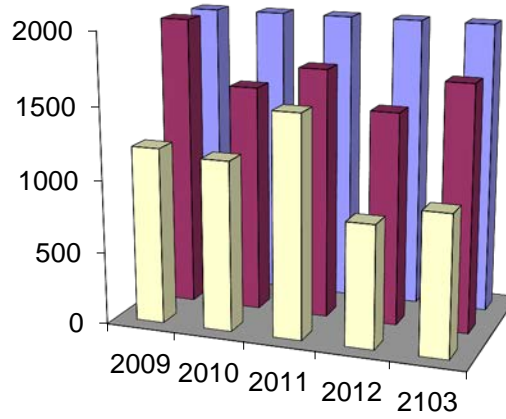

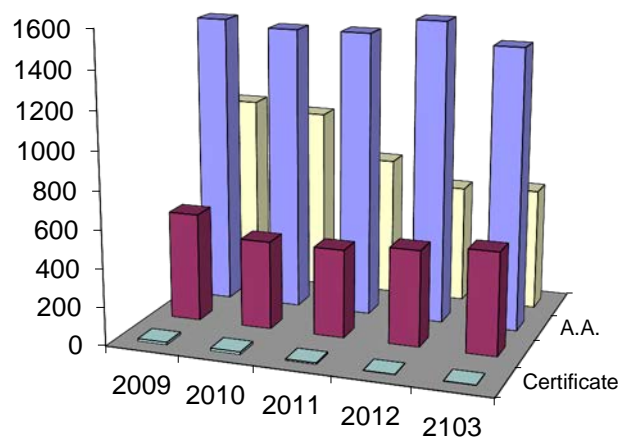
New Degree-Seeking Students Fall 2009 to Fall 2013

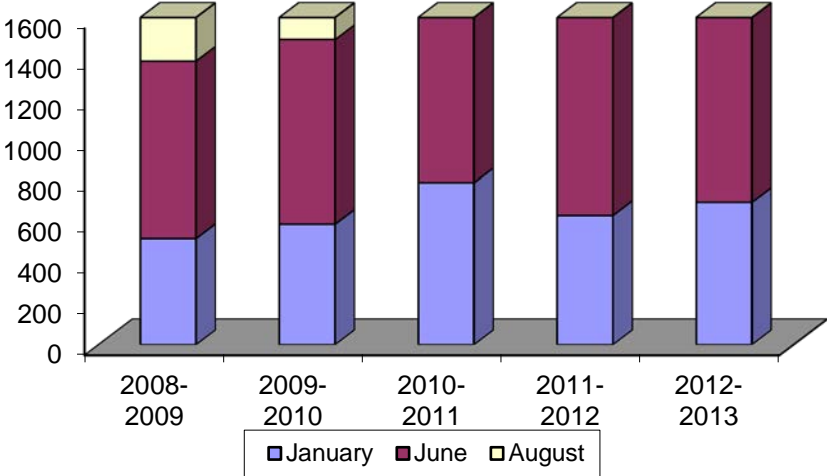

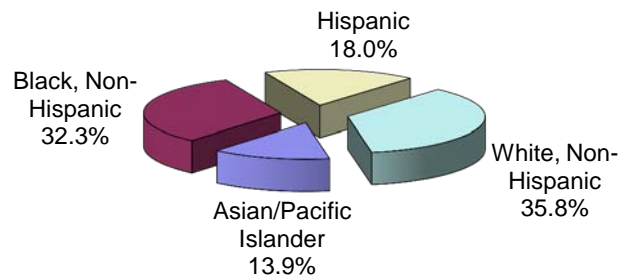
