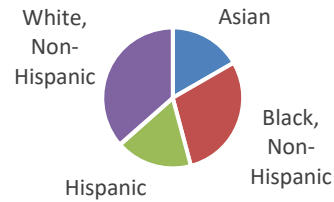

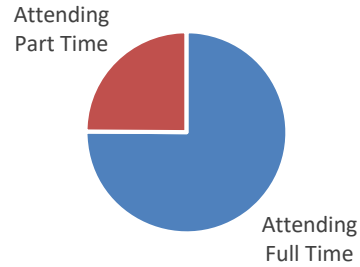

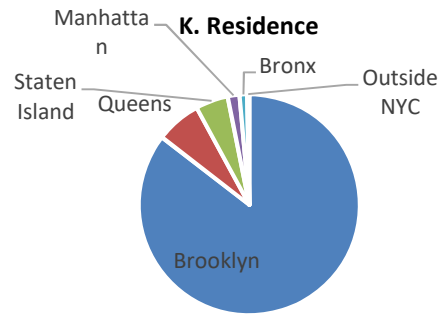

**J. Full- or Part-Time Status**



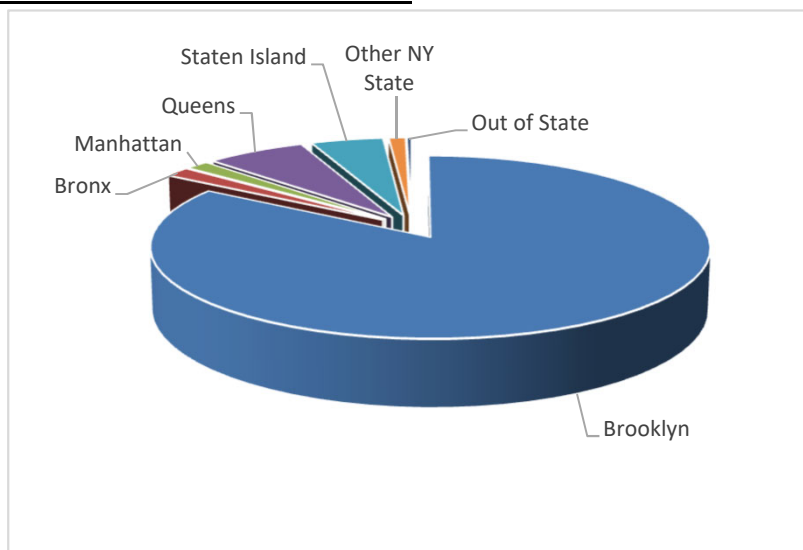

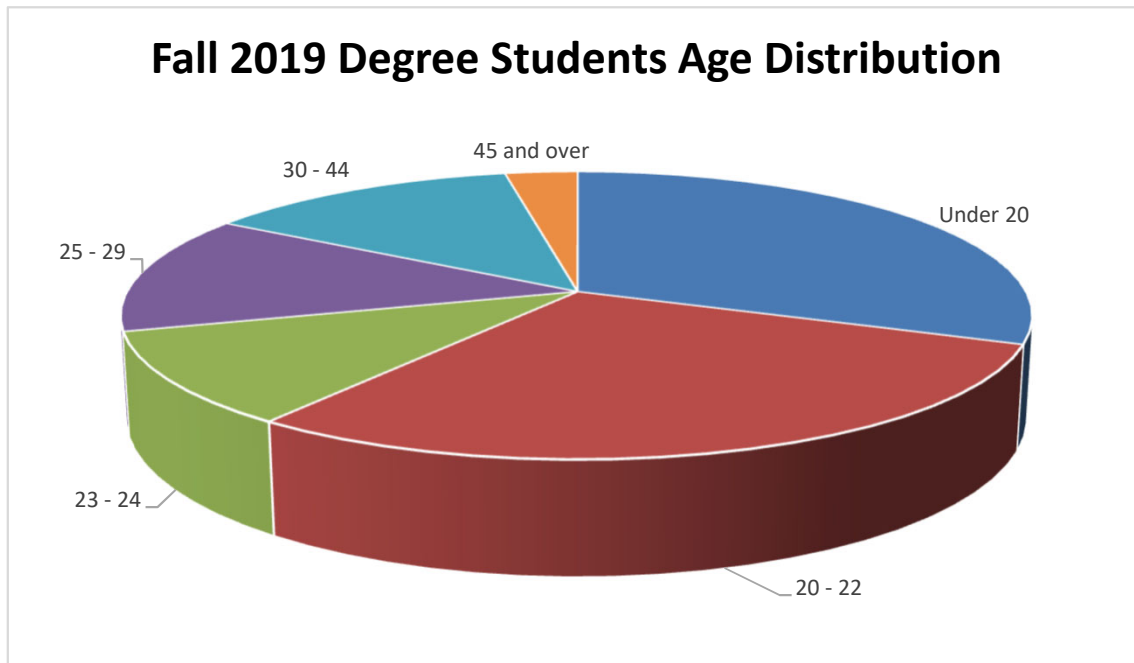

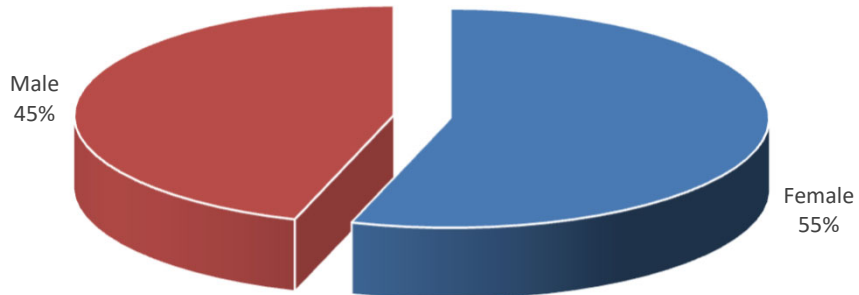

### Fall 2018 Enrollment of Men and Women



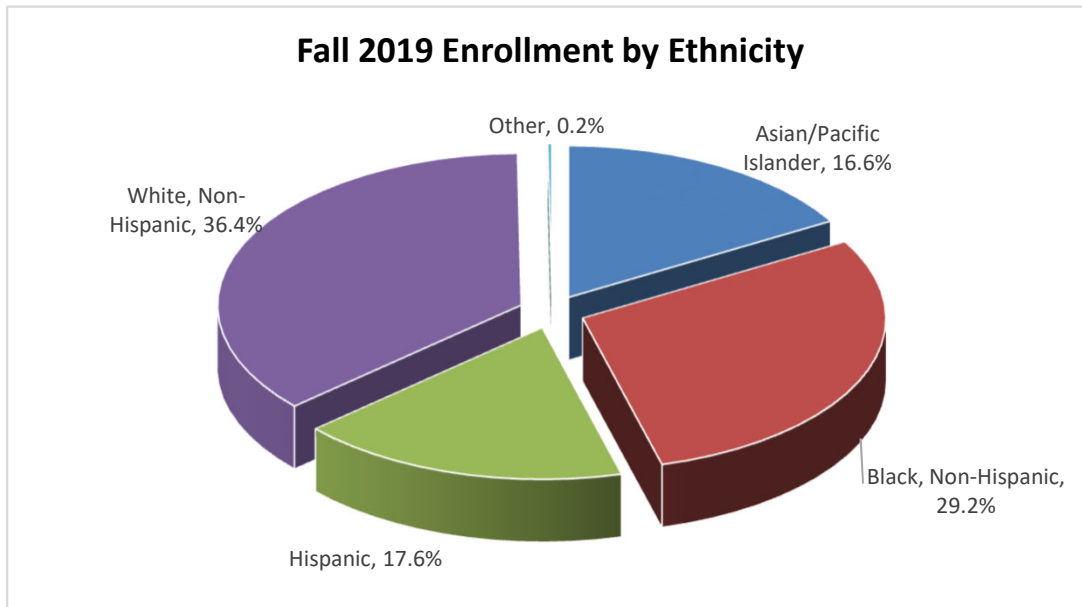

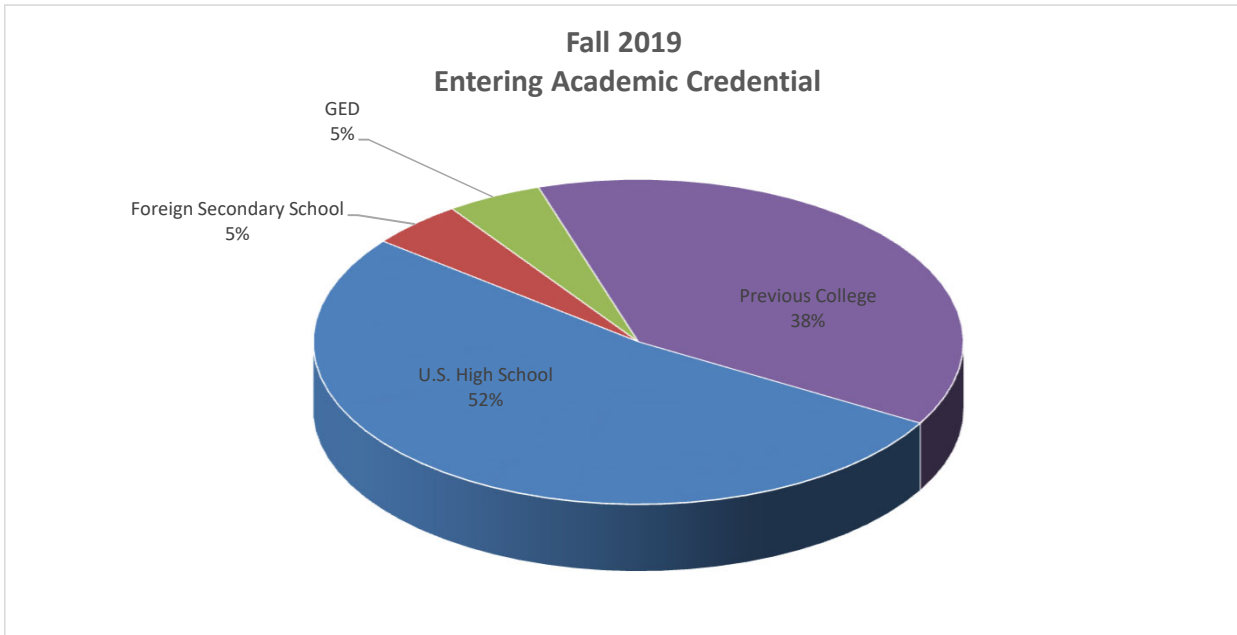

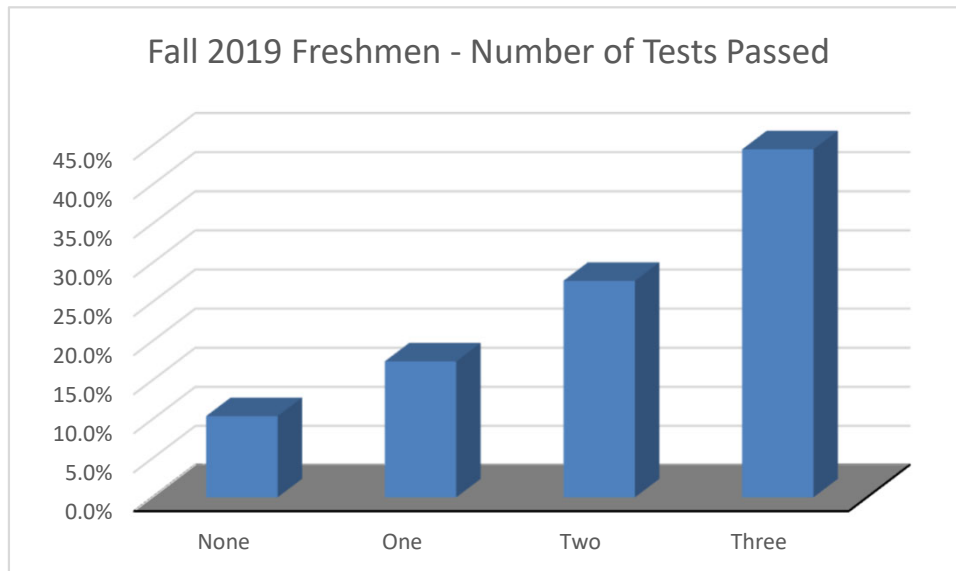

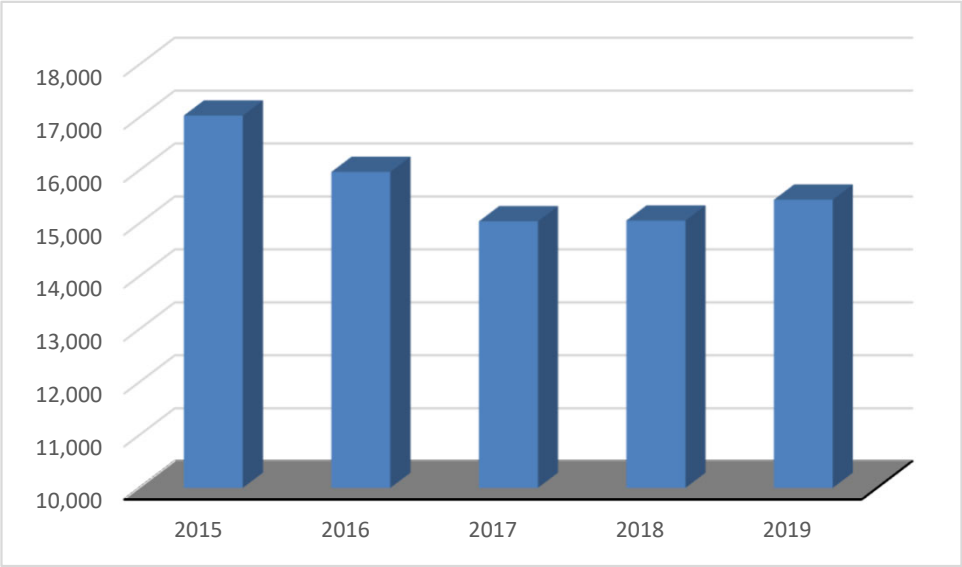

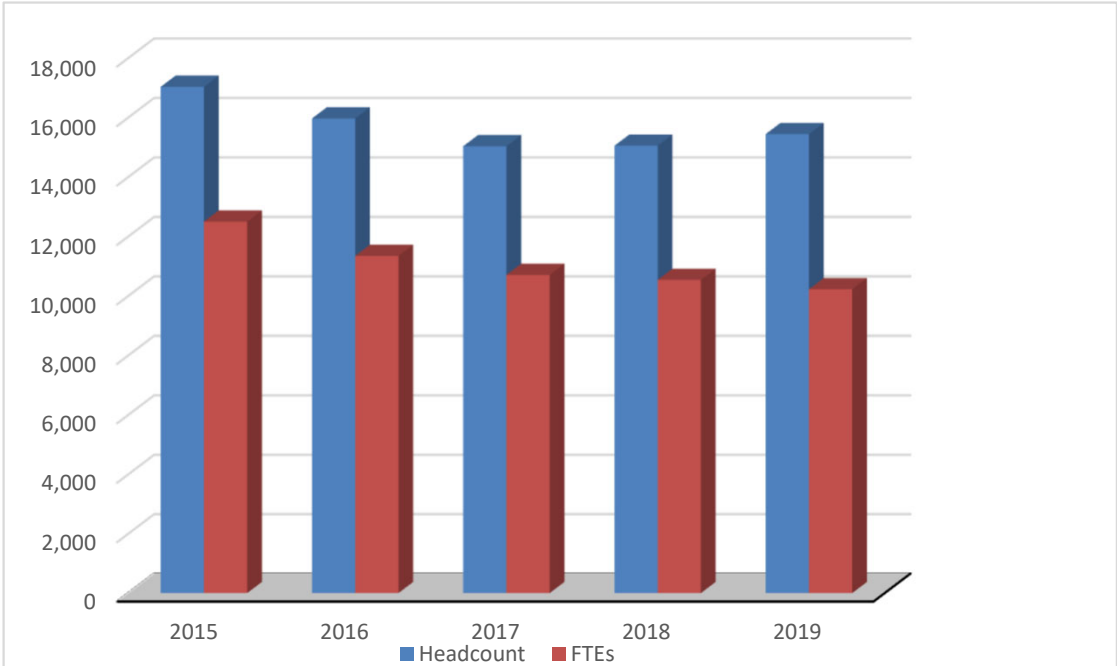

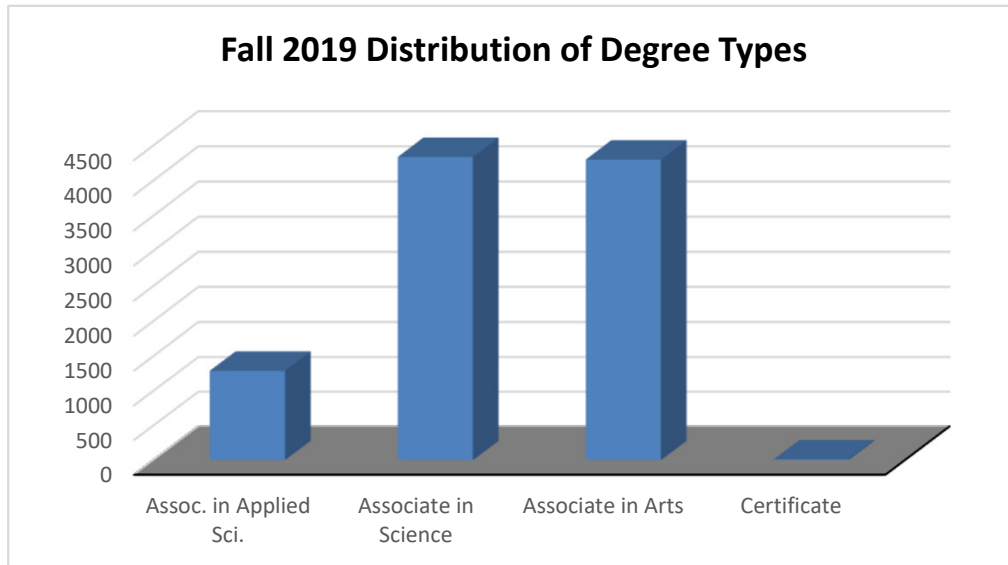

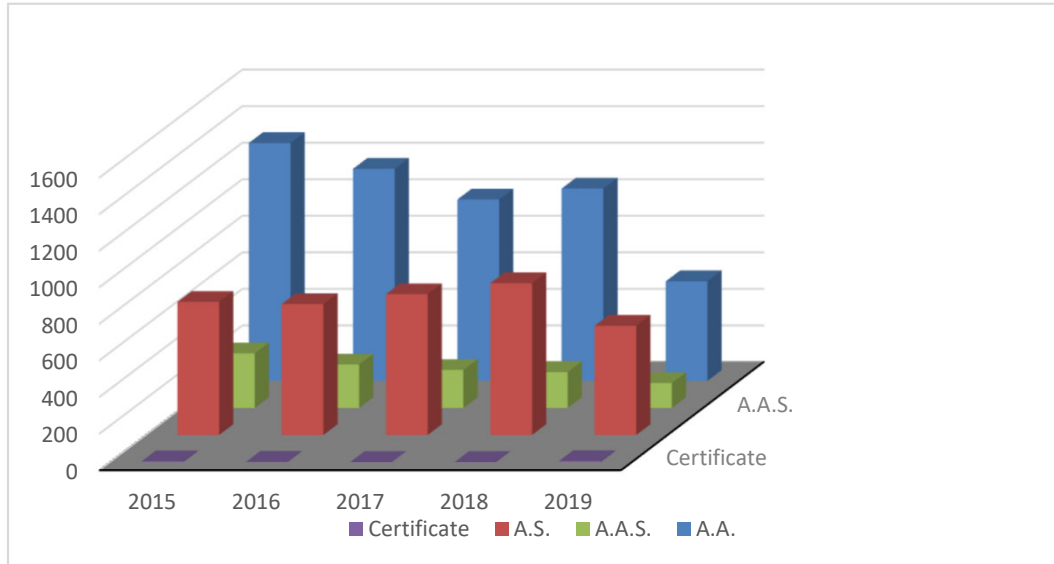

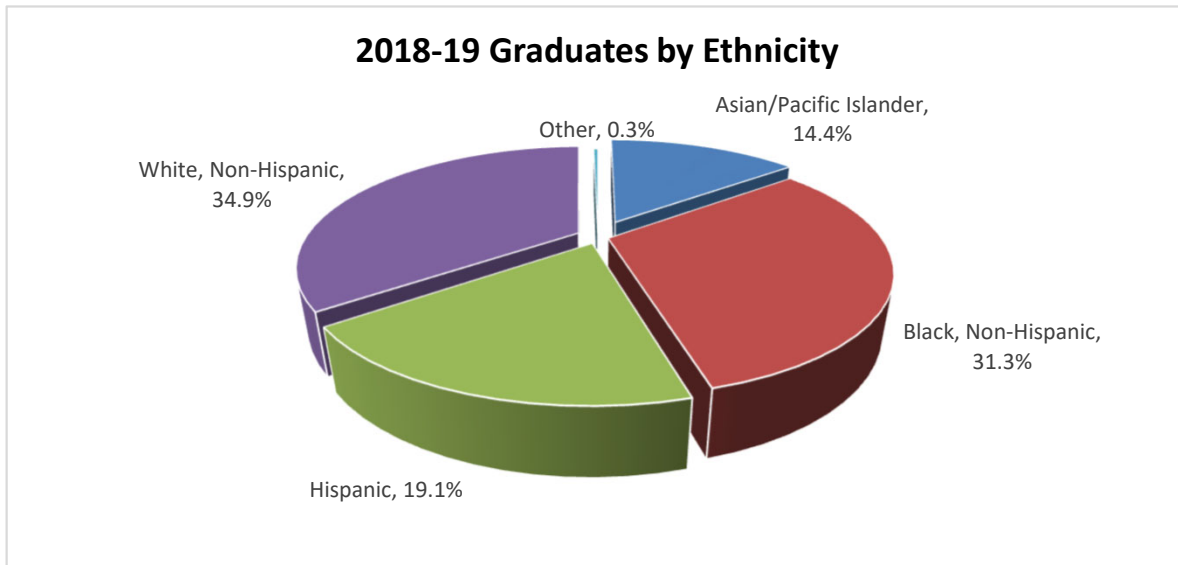

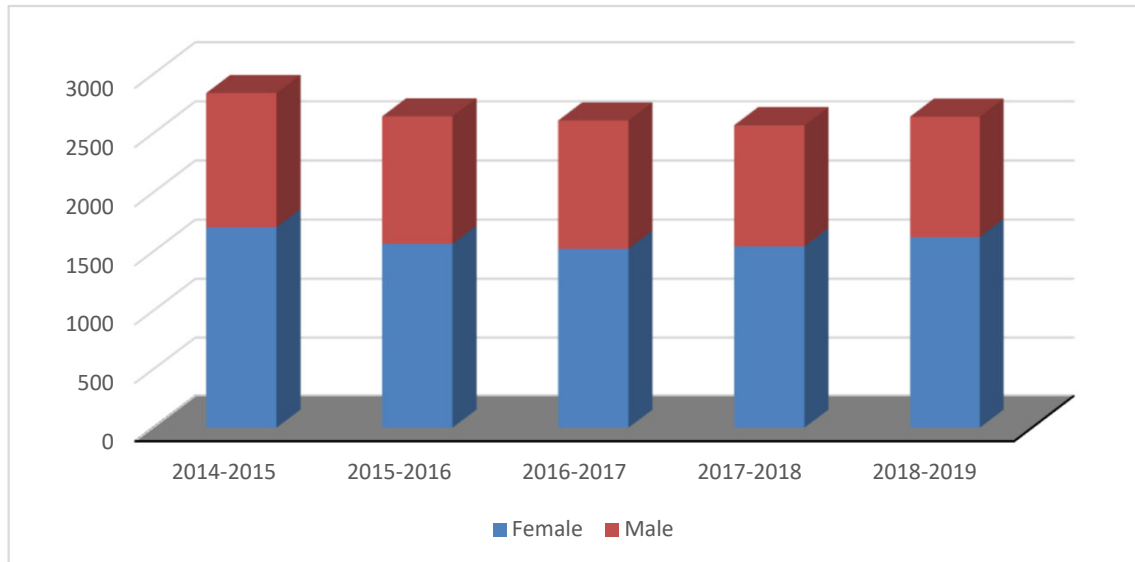

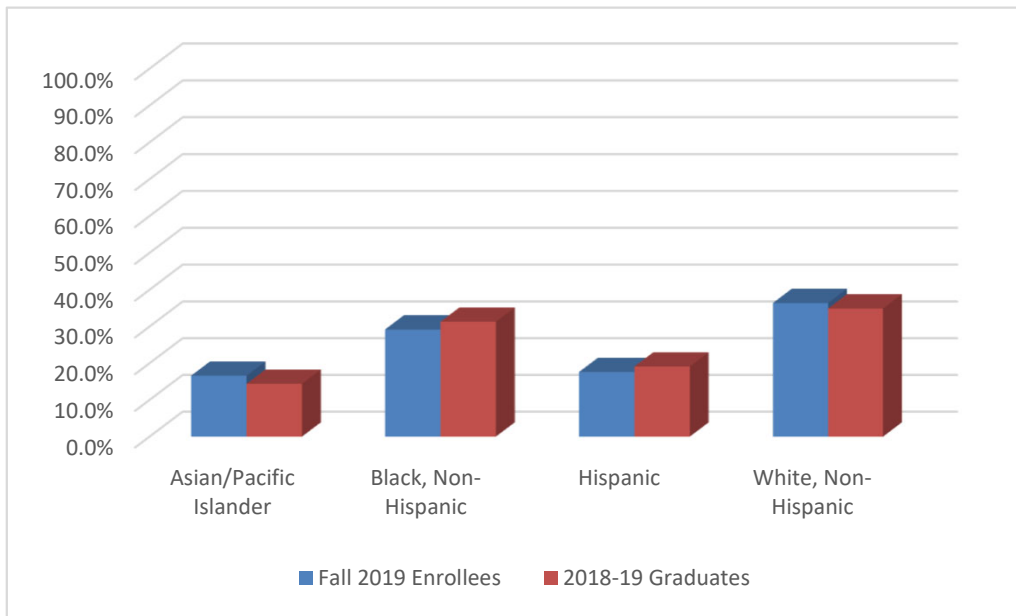
