Pathways Error for ECO 12 and HIS 70

- ECO 12 and HIS 70 were categorized incorrectly
- ECO 12, placed in Group A belongs in Group D
- HIS 70, placed in Group D belongs in Group A
- Students with a requirement term of either FALL 2014 or SPRING 2015 will have ECO 12 count as a Group A and will have HIS 70 count as a Group D
- Beginning Fall 2015 ECO 12 will be in Group D
- Beginning Fall 2015 HIS 70 will be in Group A

Pathways & Civic Engagement:

- Attached is an updated version of the Fall 2015 Approved Pathways courses. Newly approved courses are highlighted as well as the issues with ECO 12 and HIS 70.
- Remember that any newly approved courses are **ONLY** for continuing students changing their major into Pathways, brand new freshmen, brand new transfer, and brand new second degree students.
- Pathways and Civic Engagement courses are tied to the catalog year (requirement term) the student enrolled at the college or last changed their major.
- Students that have a requirement term of Fall 2015 will follow the attached lists.
- The only update for Civic Engagement is the change in designation for HE 4000 to HS 4000, which is listed as HE/HS 4000.
- Please be mindful that there are also Civic Engagement sections and components that are listed under the "Schedule of Classes" link on the Kingsborough homepage.
